When Barbara Smith, Recreation Program Coordinator at Botsford Senior Living Center, heard Jessica Twigg's heart-wrenching story of losing her son, Ethin, to a rare disease, it tugged on her heartstrings. It tugged on her residents. It tugged on their thread and their fabric.

On Saturday, October 24th, the residents of Botsford Senior Living Center are throwing open its doors to interested community members to assist with their National Make a Difference Day project – adopting Jessica's mission to provide quilts, blankets, pillows, stuffed animals and books for the children on the 5th floor at Mott Children's Hospital in Ann Arbor.

As Jessica describes it, "I am hoping to have enough blankets to hand out to the entire 5th floor of Mott's. I know it seems silly way to honor Ethin, but he never slept on a hospital blanket. Always in 5 1/2 months he was on our blankets that were either given to us or from home. I am working on making sure there will be enough stuffed animals and books for each kid too."
